Lavandula x agustifolia

Known as **English Lavender**. Is more compact. Best for culinary purposes or as a decorative plant in the garden.

Aromatico Blue Improved

20" tall & 12" wide. Dark purple flowers.

Sweet Romance

18" tall & 18" wide. Purple flowers.

Hidcote

24" tall & 24" wide. Dark purple flowers.

Munstead

18" tall & 18" wide. Light purple flowers.

Super Blue

12" tall & 12" wide. Purple blue flowers.



Lavandula x intermedia

Known as **Lavandin**; a hybrid cross between English & Portuguese lavender. Larger with longer stems and bigger flowers. High oil content.

Sensational

30" tall & 36" wide. Dark purple flowers.

Grosso

36" tall & 36" wide. Large purple flowers.

Phenomenal

36" tall & 36" wide. Dark purple blue flowers.

Provence

24" tall & 24" wide. Light purple flowers

Care Tips

SUN & WATER

Needs 6-8 hours of full sun. Thrives in most soil qualities but it must drain well. Standing water and wet areas could encourage root rot.

PRUNING

In spring, remove about one-third of the top to keep the plant from becoming leggy and bare at the base, but do not cut back into old wood, as it will not regrow.

HARVESTING

Harvest in the morning hours. Cut the stems as long as possible. Gather into bundles and secure with rubber bands. Dry bundles by hanging for a few weeks.
